PAYINGOFFMYMARKER led the way up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two path and held clear to the wire. SCARY CHERRY raced in the middle of the pack on the outside through the opening quarter, navigated the bend from the four path, began a bid entering the stretch and gained ground late. STORM IN THE VALLE bumped with the horse to his inside at the break, settled in the middle of the pack on the rail for the run up the backstretch, began a bid from the three path coming around the turn and improved position from there. HONKY TONK HONEY tracked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, swung out to the five path coming around the turn, switched inside to began a bid entering the stretch and improved position between horses to the wire. MARK THE WINNER stalked the leader between horses early, continued around the turn in the three path and was outkicked in the lane. MARK IT DOWN stumbled and bumped with the horse to his outside leaving the gate, raced off the pace on the rail up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and never threatened. MS. POUNDS chased the leader on the inside early, navigated the turn from the two path and faded in the lane. EMPRESS IN FRONT trailed the field up the backstretch, raced in the three path around the turn and made no bid. MAKE UP A STORY raced off the pace on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the three path and was empty in the lane. TRUST ANABELLE spooked a few strides out of the gate, lost his rider, and was later caught and walked off. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS MADE INTO THE START. UPON REVIEW, NO CHANGES WERE MADE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH.
