SACRED WISH stalked the top pair along the rail, roused approaching the quarter pole, asked right handed entering the lane, moved out a bit at the top of the stretch, drew alongside AG BULLET with a sixteenth remaining, dug in to take over late and held off GINA ROMANTICA in the final strides. GINA ROMANTICA settled in the two path, moved up between rivals leaving the backstretch, chased three wide into the lane, challenged three deep into the final sixteenth and could not get by SACRED WISH in the end. AG BULLET showed the way early from inside while under pressure, maintained a short lead to the far turn, cleared with a quarter mile remaining, challenged by the top pair in deep stretch and yielded late. TAXIMPLICATIONS (GB) got bumped leaving the gate, steer ed to the inside racing near the back, continued along the rail on the far turn, stayed on the fence through the lane and closed well to round out the superfecta. ASPENGROVE (IRE) broke in and bumped, raced in the two path mid-pack, chased two then three wide on the far turn, moved out in the drive and offered a mild response when called upon. CHILD OF THE MOON (FR) followed within range early from inside, chased two wide into the lane, moved out in upper stretch and kept on trying through the final furlong. MOU FFY got bumped from outside at the start, traveled near the back early on the inside, coaxed along into the far turn, advanced from the fence on the second bend, moved into range with a furlong remaining but finished evenly late. N ADETTE (FR) broke a step slow, tucked inside at the back of the pack, saved ground to the stretch, moved out in the lane and improved position. AUSSIE GIRL (IRE) pressed the pace from outside in hand early, failed to keep up with the leader at the quarter pole, chased two wide into the lane and weakened. PREREQUISITE got bumped between rivals at the start, laid well off the pace in the two path early, crept closer three deep in the middle stages, angled five wide around the far turn and failed to threaten. TIRUPATI forwardly placed two wide early, exited the backstretch three deep, came under a ride on the far turn, entered the lane in the four path and faded.
