KINETIC moved out into the first turn when forwardly placed, prompted the issue from the three path, outside bid turning for home, put a head in front approaching midstretch, lugged in to bother the tiring pacesetter, continued to drift in to the wire, fully extended to prevail. SIR GREYL IND bobbled and then broke out when recovering to hit the gate, raced in a forward position along the inside first turn, remained within striking distance second bend just off the inside, brushed with TONKA WARRIOR in upper stretch, continued on and finished willingly to be edging clear for the place, not enough for the winner. CREATIVE MINISTER in tight early, raced back, dropped to the inside for the run through the second turn, improved into the lane, up for the place while not a serious threat to the top pair. TONKA WARRIOR broke a step slow, raced well back early, raced in the two path into the lane, brushed with the runner up through upper stretch, flattened out a bit late to finish up evenly. TIME FOR TROUBLE four wide into the first turn when with the lead pace, angled in a bit to race threewide up the backstretch and into the far turn, lacked a closing punch. ARCHIE THE GIZA angled in after the start to tighten up some inner rivals, set the pace in the two path, was tiring when bothered by the winner as that one challenged while lugging in with a furlong tor un, continued to weaken. HURRY HURRY broke back, slight bother, lacked speed and failed to menace. CAROLO RAPIDO in tightearly, /five wide into the first turn, mid pack while four wide, retreated.
