MADAKET ROAD broke on top, set the pace into and through the first turn, showed the way by daylight up the backstretch, larger lead into the stretch, could not contain the winner in yielding late, fully extended to hold the place. SANDMAN unhurried in the early going, began to advance three wide far turn then moved around some traffic to be five wide into the lane, closed willingly to be getting to the runner up late. PUBLISHER broke back, remained void of speed for six furlongs, crept closer in some traffic turning for home in the three path, squeezed a furlong out, closed mildly to pick up a couple of positions late while not a serious threat. TIZTASTIC four wide into the first turn, moved in a bit to save some ground, two path through the second bend when improving a bit, moved to the rail when straightened for home, finished up evenly.
