JOHN HANCOCK set the early pace on the inside, then was engaged and dueled with OWEN ALMIGHTY by the nine sixteenths, continued that battle on the far turn and into the lane, dug in determinedly to edge clear late to prove best under a drive. OWEN ALMIGHTY prompted the winner early and then went up to duel for command and fought on through the lane but was out-gamed late while clearly second best. POSTER was settled back early, advanced four to five wide on the far turn and had a mild late rally to gain the show award late. CAMP HALE tracked the leaders and was two wide on the far turn, came three wide into the lane and drifted out a tad by the furlong marker and then was corrected and lacked the needed winning bid while losing the show award on the wire. VERY BOLD was four wide into the first turn, settled early and was three to four wide on the far turn and had no late punch while besting the rest. NAUGHTY RASCAL stalked the pace and made a three wide bid midway on the far turn but tired. DR RUBEN M chased the pace on the outside and was four wide on the far turn and tired. SMOKEN BOY was taken back early and crossed over to the rail, saved ground on the far turn and swung out seven wide leaving the turn and was not a threat. TREATY OF ROME was settled early and stopped. GATESKEEPER was settled on the inside and then was through after a half mile. New Stakes Record.
