CAUTION CARDINAL was allowed to settle, came four-wide into the stretch and finished in a mild rally. LAWS OF MAN vied for the lead for a half mile while racing three-wide but lacked the needed later response. STORMCATSONG disputed the pace for a half mile from along the inside and tired.
