BANK FRENZY was leaning on the right side stall when the latch was sprung and leaned on the off side stall at the start, chased five then four wide advancing on the front from midway on the turn to take over command in hand just inside the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch and was roused straightened away, drifted out while edging clear under a left handed crop until the final strides when corrected while kept busy to the end. WORCESTER broke out at the start bumping COASTAL MISSION. chased four then three wide downthe backstretch, briefly tucked to the two path into the turn before tipping back out three then four wide under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the finish. COASTAL MISSION got bumped at the start by the aforement ioned foe breaking outwards, chased seven then five wide coming under urging at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch offering up a bid, then weakened in the late stages. CURBSTONE chased three wide down the backstretch until tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, went eight wide into upper stretch and improved position through the stretch. YO DADDY coaxed from the gate, chased six paths off the inside in aim of the front down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn and came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into upper stretch, tired. WINNIN' ON WEEK ENDS coaxed from the gate, led early on from the four path before being displaced near the five furlong marker, prompted the leader from the outside four then three wide under urging from the three-eighths, went six to seven wide at the top of the stretch and gave way. LAW PROFESSOR chased along the inside and then just off the inside under a ride from midway on the turn, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch and folded. CONCEALED CARRY stumbled at the start, came under coaxing from the two path and rushed up to be forwardly placed before taking command nearing the five furlong marker, tucked inside into the turn and came under coaxing at the three-eighths under pressure, yielded the front just inside five-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and faltered in the drive.
