BERNIEANDTHEROSE leaned in and brushed the gate at the start, prompted the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure on the leader in the two path early on the turn, took the advantage with three fur longs to run, was put to a left-handed crop into upper stretch, battled outside of the pacesetter into the final furlong, shook off that foe coming to the sixteenth-pole and drew clear under steady urging. LOTTIE MARGARET settled on the outside, was roused in the four path on the turn, chased in the five path into upper stretch, drifted in outside the furlong marker and just got up for the place. HOWLING WIND bumped with a rival at the start, went to the front then showed the way on the inside of a foe while off the rail, was guided in leaving the backstretch, vied inside while asked on the turn, lost the advantage with three furlongs to run, fought on with the winner into the final furlong, moved out after losing touch with that foe near the sixteenth-pole and weakened then lost the place while well clear for the show. ARMY GAL stalked the pace on the outside, was given her cue in the three path on the turn then chased the leader, turned into the stretch in the four path, was carried in while remaining on her inside lead outside the furlong marker, moved back out while continuing on her incorrect lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole and tired. STORM CHANGER settled off the pace, was urged along while inside to the two path on the turn and failed to respond. BOSTON'S PHINEST bumped with a rival at the start then tossed her head briefly, settled at the rear on the outside, was roused near the nine-sixteenths pole, traveled around the turn in the four path and also failed to respond. LADY WISDOM settled towards the rear, was put to urging while dropping back late on the backstretch, moved from the three path to the rail on the turn and faltered.
