IN OUR TIME led the way while saving ground around the first turn, opened up on the field racing up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the far turn, was caught in the final furlong and chased on to the wire, in mild traffic late. POOLSIDE WITH SLIM (IRE) raced in the middle of the pack between horses through the opening half mile, began a bid from the three path coming around the second turn and improved position in the stretch. TAXI IMPLICATIONS (GB) bumped with the horse to his outside at the start, saved ground early, settled off the pace on the inside for the run up the backstretch, navigated the far turn from the two path, began a bid passing the quarter pole and gained ground late. SEE YOU AROUND (IRE) bumped with the horses to either side leaving the gate, saved ground around the first turn, came up the backstretch in the middle of the pack on the inside, continued to save ground around the far turn and finished evenly. OZARA (IRE) stalked the pace setters from the two path through the opening half mile, saved ground around the far turn and was outkicked in the lane. READY FOR SHIRL raced in the two path around the first turn, trailed the field up the backstretch, saved ground around the second bend and passed tiring horses in the stretch. POUNCE raced in the four path around the first bend, settled in the middle of the pack on the outside for the run up the backstretch, navigated the far turn from the two path and never threatened. LIFE'S AN AUDIBLE raced in the three path around the first turn, continued up the backstretch off the pace on the outside, came around the far bend in the two path and showed no kick. SISTER LOU ANN saved ground early, tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the far turn and faded in the lane. CAIRO CONSORT bumped with the horse to his inside at the break, raced in the two path around the first turn, settled off the pace between horses for the run up the backstretch, swung out to the four path coming around the far turn, made no bid, and after galloping out, left the track in an equine ambulance, after walking onto the van.
