1 MILE. (Turf) (1.31<sup>2</sup>) HONEY FOX S. Grade III. Purse \$165,000 (includes\$15,000 FTBOA – FLTB Owner Brdr Assoc Fund) FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPW ARD. Free nomination by Sunday, February 16. \$1,500 to enter. A supplemental nomination fee of \$150 may be made prior to closing time of entries. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth throughlast, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% tofifth. (FTBOA offers \$15,000 to the owners of a registered Florida – bred divided \$8,000 to the winner, \$5,000 to second, \$2,000 to third). Weight: 123 lbs. Non–winners of a graded stakes on turf since August 1 allowed 3 lbs.; a stakes race on turf since May 1 or three races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State– Bred allowance, 5 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners in 2024–25, graded stakes placed in 2024–25 then by highest care er earnings. In the event this race is tak en off the turf, it may be subjectto downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the Tapeta Course at One Mile and Seventy Yards) (Rail at 59 feet).
