MO PLEX disputed the pace on the outside of a rival, was asked in the two path on the turn, dueled outside of the runner-up in the stretch and gamely prevailed under strong urging. FASTER GAT OR contested the pace on the inside of an opponent, vied along the rail on the turn, was given his cue near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a left-handed crop in upper stretch, dueled gamely inside of the winner to the finish and was denied while able to get the place. PAS CALINE settled just off the pace on the inside, was roused while moving to the two path nearing the five-sixteenths pole, came out into upper stretch, pursued the top two while outside in the drive and finished with good courage but missed while well clear for the show. SHARE THE LUDT angled out early then stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the three path on the turn, turned into the stretch in the four path while under the crop then moved further out in the drive and tired. MCKELLEN was last away, settled on the outside, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, went around most of the turn in the four path, dropped to the three path outside the quarter-pole, moved inward in upper stretch and came up empty.
