By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,250 to enter and an additional \$1,250 to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed plus an additional \$100,000 KTDF for KTDF eligible horses. After payment of 1.25% to each owner of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining association purse will be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth. KTDF funds correspondingly divided providing a KTDF eligible horse finishes in an award position. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since November 1, allowed 3 lbs.; a graded stakes since July 4, 5 lbs. The Commonwealth will be limited to twelve starters with four also eligibles. In the event that more than twelve pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I–II–III), then highest earnings in 2024–2025. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Nominations Closed Wednesday, March 19, 2025 with 35 Nominations.

EXTRA ANEJO laid off of the pace in the three to two path, shifted out to the five path while picking up stride in upper stretch and rallied to reel in the clear leader in the final sixteenth. MONTALCINO rushed forwardly after a bit of a flat-footed beginning, showed the way while remaining multiple paths off of the inner rail, remained in the three path as an outer pair applied pressure returning for home, shook clear in upper stretch but was caught by an outer challenger with seventy yards to go. HOIST THE GOLD raced forwardly in the five path, brushed with an outer rival with nine sixteenths to go, sustained pressure outside of the top pair while kept in the five path around the bend, but failed to keep pace with the leader in upper stretch and got outkicked for place by an outer bidder in the final furlong. EPIC RIDE pressed the leader from the four path and between horses, sustained pressure along with an outer rival around the turn, but gave way in upper stretch then narrowly lasted for fourth between horses. ASHCROFT laid well back three wide, then stayed on between horses in the four path and missed fourth. CAMEL CHIP pursued along the inside, chased in the two to three path in upper stretch and ran on mildly between horses. PRINCE OF POWER chased in the six path and between rivals, brushed with those foes with nine sixteenths to go, tucked behind them into the turn, saved ground turning for home, chased in upper stretch and lacked a bid. NUTELLA FELLA was unruly loading, trailed in the two to four path, fanned out to the six path into the lane, stayed on while hanging on his left lead, but saw his rider lose his crop at the furlong grounds and flattened out. BEST ACTOR lacked speed along the inside, moved to the three path in upper stretch and failed to factor while hanging on his left lead. HERE MI SONG broke a step slow, raced well back two wide and between horses, then failed to factor. SURLY FURIOUS chased in the seven path, brushed with an inner rival at the nine sixteenth pole, pursued in the six path around the turn and faded entering the lane.
