HEROIC MOVE broke a lertly then showed the way into the first turn, was engaged by PINEY BLUFF and disputed the pace inside of that rival heading to the half-mile pole, shook free from that foe then dueled BATTLE STRIKE into the far turn, repelled that rival into upper stretch, kicked clear into the lane then drew off in the late stages to win as much the best. BEARINGS tracked the early pace from the second flight, raced a bit in tight while between runners through the backstretch, weaved through traffic into upper stretch then found room along the rail at the furlong grounds, could not impact the winner late and outfinished the rest for second. MINE THAT STAR in tight and steadied while onheels into the first turn, tracked the pace while in a bit tight through the backstretch, found room outside of rivals into the far turn, got floated five to six wide into upper stretch, rallied to the furlong marker, stayed on to deep stretch and just missed for second, while just holding for third. BLUE DEVIL tracked the early pace from between runners, chased from the inside into the far turn, ran in pursuit into upper stretch, could not find the needed response into the final sixteenth and was outfinished for the minor awards. TIBURON took up and was shuffled back on the run to the first turn, tracked the pace from outside of runners into the backstretch, made a four wide middle move then chased the pace to the second turn, drifted out nearing the top of the lane, chased into the stretch then could not muster a late response. BATTLE STRIKE prominent early, stalked the pace from the inside into the backstretch, went up and dueled HEROIC MOVE into the second turn, was repelled into upper stretch then faded through the final furlong. BENDER unhurried away from the start, lagged along the backstretch run, saved ground to the second turn, spun three to four wide into upper stretch then did not factor in the late stages. HENRY ONTHE RUN close up in the early stages, tracked the pace three wide into the backstretch, raced a bit in tight at the half-mile marker, shifted to the rail and chased from the inside along the far turn, lacked a response into upper stretch and gave way. PINEY BLUFF prominent while four wide into the first turn, contested the pace with HEROIC MOVE into the backstretch run, disputed moderate fractions while three to four deep nearing the half-mile marker, dropped back along the second turn then came up empty in the stretch.
