DETERMINISTIC coaxed from the gate, showed the way just off the inside past the stands the initial time before tucking inside into the first turn, remained along the rail into and down the backstretch settled into a comfortable rhythm, got given a notch inside three furlongs to run and began to shake away, the field in behind getting busy, got roused to a drive taking the inside route into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive being flashed the crop to the right side, then got placed back in hand inside the final forty yards while setting a course record. CARSON'S RUN saved ground at the tail of the compact field until tipped three wide three furlongs out placed to urging, angled four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive running on to chase the winner home clear of the rest and along second best. KAY ARMY (CHI) settled tracking the leader in closest aim just off the inside through the first turn and down the backstretch, came under coaxing at the three-eighths marker when DETERMINISTIC began to slip away, swung three wide at the top of the stretch and weakened in the late stages. MASTER PIECE (CHI) coaxed from the start, tracked the pace along the inside coming under a ride with seven-sixteenths to go in concert with TUSCAN SKY, continued in the inside route into upper stretch and tired in the drive. TUSCAN SKY just off the inside through the first turn, chased three then two wide getting put to urging at the seven-sixteenths in tandem with MASTER PIECE, tipped three to four wide at the head of the lane, tired in the stretch.
