CLOCK TOWER vied briefly with a pair of rivals from the two path before shaking away in tandem with JET SWEEP JOE to engage in head to head combat through the turn patiently handled until set down taking the inside route into upperstretch, edged clear under a drive and was kept to task. FLAT TO DA MAT chased along the inside on hold until let out spinning from the two path into upper stretch, offered up a mildkick to get up for the place honors while never threatening the winner. IN SUBORDINATION (IRE) chased just off the inside from mid pack coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. JET SWEEP JOE coaxed from the gate, vied from the three path briefly with a pair of rivals to his inside, then dueled through the turn outside of CLOCK TOWER and was roused spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. ASSERTIVENESS broke in a step at the start and was corrected, chased three then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled four to five wide for home and kicked on belatedly to the finish. SUPERSONIC BLUE chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch, briefly tucked to the two path before heading back outside four wide inside the half mile pole, chased three wide through the turn and angled six wide into upper stretch, then passed tired rivals to the finish. WARHEART coaxed from the gate, chased four then three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, tipped four wide into upper stretch, offered no response. PIVOTAL MOMENT four wide in pursuit, got ridden along at the five-six teenths, tipped out five wide at the top of the stretch, tired. SUPER SWIFT advanced after the start and vied briefly inside a pair of rivals until shaken off inside the nine-sixteenths, chased along the inside through the turn and cut the corner roused at the head of the lane, then tired in the stretch.
