MADAKET ROAD stalked the pace from the two path early on, ran near the rail along the turn, shifted into the four path entering thelane, was no match for the winner late and held place in the final stages. GAMING was bumped and bothered at the start, tracked the pace early from the five path, raced two wide along the turn, was in the five path into the lane and missed place in the final stages. GATE TO WIRE was bumped and bothered at the start, trailed the field early on from the three path, shifted into the six path entering the lane and moved up late in the stretch run. PERFECT FORCE hopped at the start and raced back early on, was in the three path along the turn, swung into the six path entering the lane and improved position down the lane. SMOKEN WICKED was bumped and bothered at the start, tracked the pace early along the four path, raced near the rail in the turn, tipped into the two path into the lane and weakened late in the stretch drive. INNOVATOR chased the pace from thesix path, raced two wide in the turn, was in the four path into the lane and faded late in the stretch. CALIF ORNIA BURRITO came out at the start and was done early. BUILT was through after a half.
