DURANTE shifted outwardly while breaking on top, vied with an outer pair of bidders early on, backed off of them to stalk passing the half mile pole, tipped to the four path to take aim outside of them entering upper stretch, rallied to bid in the final furlong, gained command leaving the sixteenth pole and edged ahead. WORLD RECORD vied three wide early on, dueled two wide while kept in the three path around the turn, forged an advantage entering the lane, delayed changing leads until the three sixteenths pole, led into the final furlong, but got collared and bested by an outer bidder at the sixteenth pole and held place between challengers late. GIANT MISCHIEF tracked in the three to four path around the turn, fanned out to the six path entering the lane, closed in with gradual progress through the final furlong and dead-heated with an inner rival for show. HAPPY IS A CHOICE trailed in the two to three path, then ran on willingly to share show. HERE MI SONG raced off of the pace in the four to five path, drifted out to the seven path entering the lane and made little impact. SKELLY vied two wide and between horses early on, dueled with his outer counterpart while remaining a path off of the inside around the turn, got headed entering the lane, fought on until weakening in midstretch and stopped.
