After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last the purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the winning owner. Management reserves the right to cancel this race with less than six betting interests. Closed on Wednesday, April 30, 2025, with 32 Nominations. If this race is taken off the turf, it will be run at 1 mile and 70 yards on the main track. (ORIGINALLY SCHEDULED FOR TURF AT 1 MILE).
