Starters to pay an additional \$1,500. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry in the amount of \$4,500 and shall include all fees. After payment of 1.5% of the purse to all owners finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the winning owner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. If less than five horses start, the remaining purse will be distributed to the winning owner.\*TTA Event Funds are paid directly from the Texas Thoroughbred Association. Weights: 124 lbs. First preference will be given to highest lifetime earnings in order Grade I, II, III Stakes. Second preference to highest lifetime earnings. Lifetime earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. This race will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

INSTANTREPLAY rated along the inside, angled out off the inside through the upper lane, took aim on the top pair and finished well to edge up under all out pressure. ITSMYBIRTHDAY tracked the early leader two deep, challenged Take Charge Top through the far turn, dug in between deep stretch and finished gamely to the wire. TAKE CHARGE TOM was away alertly, controlled the early pace along the inside, challenged through the far turn and gave way grudgingly to the top pair. MISTER OMAHA settled off the early going racing in hand, had an inside run and moved up late to improve position. JUST CLASSIC raced four wide around the first turn, settled off the early pace, ridden three wide between through the far turn moved up to challenge and flattened out in the drive. JOLLY SAMURAI was unhurried early, raced from the inside near the five sixteenths pole, angled out near the three sixteenths pole to race from the far outside and was even with no final bid. TEXIANDEVIL stalked the pace, raced five wide around the first turn, was four deep around the far turn and weakened a bit through the drive. COUNTTHEBRAVE raced seven wide around the first turn, mid pack early, was five deep around the far turn and raced evenly to the wire. ROYALIST was slowearly, raced three wide around the far turn and lacked a bid. INDECISIVENESS raced six wide around the first turn, three deep around the far turn, stopped and eased up on through the stretch run.
