HEROIC MOVE rated along to race in hand, five wide near the quarter pole and finished willingly tot the wire. CREATIVE MINISTER unhurried early on, raced five wide near the quarter pole, seven deep into the upper stretch and moved up to improve position. TOU CHUPONASTAR stalked the pace, ridden along three wide near the quarter pole and weakened. NU MBER ONE DUDE tracked the early pair from the inside of rivals and weakened a bit through the drive. BLUE DEVIL raced with the second flight early on, six wide around the first turn, raced four wide around the far turn and never threatened. U. S. ARMY broke awkwardly, trailed early on after the poor start, swung wide into the lane and never menaced. THE WINE STEWARD raced five wide into the first turn, raced four wide around the far turn and through the far turn and failed to respond.
