TWAIN stalked the pace hugging the inner rail, advanced inside foes to reach contention in mid stretch and flattened out. BARBADIAN RUNNER, patiently handled along the inner rail, eased out approaching the stretch, swung to the six path in upper stretch and passed tired rivals. CURAHEE lightly bumped with STORMY FLIGHT soon after the break, sprinted clear and moved to the inner rail on the first turn, set the pace to mid stretch and gave way. STORMY FLIGHT lightly bumped with CURAHEE soon after the start, chased that one on his outside and gave way in upper stretch. STUDLYDORIGHT was outrun.
