6 FURLONGS. (1.071) GOLDFINCH S. Purse \$50,000 FOR THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 in 2024-2025 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$45,000 in 2024-2025 allowed 4 lbs.; \$30,000 in 2024-2025 allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered) No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start. \$50,000 guaranteed which will first be reduced so as to allow \$500 to be paid to each of the seventh through last place finishers with the remaining purse paid out as follows: 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS AT TIME OF ENTRY WITH A FEE OF \$750 TO ENTER AND START. Starters to be named at the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds twelve (12), high weights will be preferred, then highest lifetime earnings. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees.

RICH CITY GIRL came away in good order and vied for the early lead while racing under a slight hold, let out a notch entering the turn, quickly widened to a clear advantage, came two to three wide entering the head of the lane, shook the reins, responded willingly, tapped once in the final furlong and remained clear while confidently handled. KEEPSAKE was allowed to settle off the pace in the opening quarter, picked up the tempo entering the far turn, crept closer three wide near the quarter pole, hustled along three then two wide down the lane and ran on with good response. ALEXANDRA ELAINE vied inside of RICH CITY GIRL up the backstretch, could not match strides with the eventual winner upon entering the turn but ran on with response and finished well clear over the rest. BATTLESHIPPER raced in contention off the top embattled flight in the opening quarter, coaxed four wide around the turn, failed to gain ground and weakened off the top trio in the lane. BLACK GINGER raced off the early pace, hustled along three wide into the upper stretch and passed tiring foes. TWO BAR sat off the early speed, coaxed three wide around the far turn, swung four wide into the drive and failed to threaten. CARSON BAY dueled between foes up the backstretch, could not match strides around the turn and tired in the drive. SQUEEZE THE DAY reared and came away slowly at the start, trailed the field, saved ground then angled out but failed to recover from the poor start. LIT MISS HAT TRICK raced in contention in the opening quarter then faded around the far turn. A THOUSAND MILES chased near midpack along the inside then steadily weakened around the turn.
