C W CHARM off slow to begin, was unhurried to the backstretch, advanced along the second turn then loomed from the inside into upper stretch, responded in the drive, took command at the sixteenth-pole and drew away under urging in deep stretch. OKIE MAGIC close up to the early pace, stalked three wide and between runners into the first turn, well placed into the backstretch run, bid threewide nearing the guarter marker and led into upper stretch, kept to task to the furlong marker, was overtaken into the final sixteenth, could not keep pace with the winner into deep stretch and held late for the place. LETTA'S LEGACY stalked the early pace four wide and between runners, chased to the quarter marker then ran in pursuit into upper stretch, battled to the furlong grounds then was outkicked into the final sixteenth, could not get by OKIE MAGIC for second in deep stretch and held clearly for third. KISS AND TELL showed early speed and assumed command into the first turn, set a pressured pace up the backstretch, led into the second turn then was overtaken nearing the quarter marker, battled into the stretch then left the rail open at the furlong grounds, could not keep pace into the final sixteenth and weakened late. CATALE WINEMIXER prominent away from the start, prompted the pace two wide and between runners up the backstretch, dueled between runners into the second turn then lost position at the quarter pole, could not keep pace into upper stretch and gave way in the final furlong. READY allowed to settle while never far back, tracked the pace from the inside up the backstretch, was outrun to the second turn and tired in the late stages. TAKE ME SERIOUS a step slow away from the start, was forwardly placed while widest into the first turn, stalked the pace five wide up the backstretch, maintained a wide trip to the second turn and chased to the quarter marker, could not find more into upper stretch and came upempty in the late stages. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using vide o technology to arrive at the most accurate time available.
