SUSHI MAN dashed away from the gate in hand with ears pricked, opened a clear, well rated, comfortable lead down the backstretch, responded when called upon turning for home to kick away and drew off unchallenged easily through the lane in an impressive effort. HOMIE stalked the winner in striking position to the far turn, responded when called upon, failed to gain on the leader, chased that one down the lane and held the place while weakening in the final sixteenth. INNATELY GOOD rated in mid-pack racing between rivals to the far turn and rallied in upper stretch with a late gain to just miss the place. CANYON STREAK tracked the leaders from mid-pack while caught five wide, was put to an early drive on the turn and came home with a grinding mild bid. SMOKEN BOY saved ground with a rail trip in striking distance into the far turn and failed to gain under a drive finishing evenly. SEAHORSE STAMPEDE trailed to the head of the lane while racing along the fence and passed tiring rivals in the lane. R N R AUDIBLE tracked the leaders from three wide to the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. BENANDONNER chased the field from five wide into the turn and faded midway on the bend.
