PRIN CESSATTITUDE tracked along the inside, bided time among foes in the two path turning for home, progressed between rivals in upper stretch and edged place with a sixteenth to go. VIXEN settled off of the pace along the inside, shifted out turning for home, fanned to the five path and between horses entering upper stretch and ran on willingly to reach show late. NINTH ISLAND prompted three deep and from the four path around the first turn, tugged to the front while tucking two wide at the five fur long pole, led along the inside around the far turn, but got collared by the eventual winner in upper stretch, yielded through the final furlong and lost show late. FAVOR TO YOUrated at the rear two wide, then in the three to four path around teh far turn before floating to the six path into the lane, then moved up without threatening. SOMETHING STRONGER set the pace along the inside, got headed by an early outer bidder with five furlongs to go, stalked around the far turn and gave way. LOVE YOU ANYW AY stalked in the three path, then within range around the far turn and faded in the four path and between horses in upper stretch.
