PERCY'S BAR raced off of the pace in the three to two path, launched progress in the three path into the turn, ranged up outside of the leading trio to issue a bold four wide challenge entering the lane, took charge shortly after, kicked clear and held sway. JABOSS bumped the gate and was off slow, trailed in the three path, advanced between horses passing the three furlong pole, swung out to the five path into the lane and sustained her charge to edge place in midstretch. COLOR COMIN' IN prompted three deep, got outkicked by an outer rival while inching place entering the lane, but yielded that position to an outer rival in midstretch and held show late. AMERICATHEGREAT lacked speed while remaining a path off of the inside, shifted out to the six path into upper stretch and ran on willingly. LILIES NPARADISE raced forwardly four wide before tucking behind the leading trio with ahalf mile to go, stalked while awaiting racing room in the two path around the bend, tipped out four wide into the lane, stayed on to bid for place between horses leaving upper stretch, but flattened out and gave way. LIGHT WON UP was hustled to vie between horses early on, brushed an inner rival while securing position reaching the five furlong pole, led narrowly two wide and between horses around the turn, offered no resistance to a wider challenge entering the lane and faded. ESSENTIAL COFFEE veered inwardly shortly after the start, prompted along the inside, got brushed by an outer rival and subtly checked reaching the five furlong pole, yet sustained position in the aftermath, vied inside of a pair of rivals around the turn, faded inside of a trio of foes entering the lane and caved. MINE STRIKE brushed the starting gate and bobbled at the start, pursued from midpack in the four to five path, weakened with three furlongs to go and was eased through the lane.
