PIN UP BETTY bobbled subtly and was bumped by an inner rival into an outer foe at the start, laid off of the pace in the three path, gained in the four path turning for home, fanned to the five path entering the lane, sustained her gradual progress to bid in midstretch and edged past before holding late. DUVET DAY (IRE) settled at the rear along the inside, then in the two path around the far turn, swung out to the five to six path into upper stretch and rallied in the final furlong to reach place in the shadow of the wire. LONG AGO (GB) brushed with an inner rival at the start, tracked the top pair from the two path, crept into striking range three deep around the far turn, bid along with an outer rival in midstretch, vied leaving the furlong grounds, but was bested in the final sixteenth and lost place late. SPARKLE BLUE saved ground off of the pace, chased in the two path in upper stretch, tipped outwardly in the final furlong and stayed on between horses late. CHARLENE'S DREAM was bumped by an inner rival soon after the start, pressed two wide, stalked down the backstretch before rebidding around the far turn, forged an advantage in upper stretch, but was collared by an outer pair at the furlong grounds and yiel ded. EVERLAND broke outwardly and bumped a foe at the start, raced at the rear two wide, then in the three path around the far turn, fanned out to the six to eight path into upper stretch and failed to menace. GENEROUS LOVER brushed with an outer rival leaving the gate, set the pace along the inside through quick splits, vied with an outer bidder turning for home, got headed in upper stretch and weakened.
