Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry for \$1,125 and shall include all fees. After payment of 1.5% of the purse to all owners finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the winning owner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. If less than five horses start, the remaining purse will be distributed to the winning owner. *TTA Event Funds are paid directly from the Texas Thoroughbred Association. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Weights: Three Year Olds, 1211bs. Older, 1241bs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2025 allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of \$15,000 since December 8, 2024 allowed 4 lbs.; Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Total earnings in 2024-2025, as determined by the information provided by Equibase Company, will be used in determining the order of preference. The field will be limited to fourteenstarters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

TOO MUCH ACTION set a pressured early pace, raced off the rail through the turn, drifted out in early stretch, and drew off as an easy winner. TURN NORTH was reserved early, made a five wide middle move through the turn, was no match late and was second best. TX CODE was allowed to settle early from between rivals and held for third. DUST EM was void of speed, raced five wide into the turn, passed rivals and offered no rally. RING SEEKER stalked the early pace from the inside and faded. COALCOWBOY tracked the early, went three wide and was empty. MISTER MONTE CARLO was taken back early, raced along the inside, angled out through the turn and was no factor. TEAM GORMLEY pressed the early pace, raced five wide and tired. BLING MOUNTAIN raced in mid pack early, went six wide and was no factor. ZAVALA was unhurried early, raced seven wide through the turn and never fired.
