1 MILE. (1.35) PANTHERS S. Purse \$50,000 FOR THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2024-2025 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$45,000 at a mile or over in 2024-2025 allowed 4 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2024-2025 allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered) No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start. \$50,000 guaranteed which will first be reduced so as to allow \$500 to be paid to each of the seventh through last place finishers with the remaining purse paid out as follows: 60% to the owner of the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS AT TIME OF ENTRY WITH A FEE OF \$750 TO ENTER AND START. Starters to be named through the entry-box by the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds ten (10), high weights will be preferred, then highest 2024-2025 earnings at closing time of entries. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second parts of the same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed on Saturday, May 24, 2025 with 17 nominations.

A THOUSAND MILES pressed the pace leaving the first turn and into the backstretch, took a slim lead at the half mile marker, widened advantage under a ride late on the far turn, saved ground entering the upper stretch, pulled away along the inside, tapped once in the final furlong and kept to task under a brisk hand ride. CALIENTE STAR raced in range around the first turn and stalked the pace up the backstretch, came under a ride mid-way around the final turn, sustained bid into the stretch run and held second best. KERRY'S KISS was allowed to settle out of the gate and raced three wide into the first turn, edged closer and tracked the pace along the outside up the backstretch, continued in good position around the far turn, given cue three wide at the head of the lane, was no match for pulling away winner but ran on and just lasted for show. TWO BAR raced in close contention along the rail heading into the first turn, was a bit keen and steadied sharply entering the backstretch, was not far back through early stages then weakened entering the far turn, shifted out five wide for rebid at the head of the lane, showed interest late and narrowly missed runner up spots. SQUEEZE THE DAY led the way around the first turn, set a pressured pace in the early backstretch, got collared for the lead near the half mile marker, flattened around the turn and continued to tire in the drive.
