WARRIOR JOHNY was away in good order and allowed to settle out of the gate, raced three wide entering the first turn, continued three wide in range sitting just off the early pace, let out a notch late on the backstretch, advanced to engage the top pair with three furlongs left to run, held a slim lead over CORNISHMAN late on the far turn, came three paths wide into the upper stretch, responded under right handed pressure, shifted in a path, held a slim advantage over stubborn rail running CORNISH MAN, fought on gamely and held firm. CORNISH MAN pressed the pace leaving the first turn and continued to force the issue up the backstretch, vied with WARRIOR JOHNNY going by the quarter pole, came two wide into the upper stretch then angled to the rail, raced in aim for the lead, battled on gamely but could not get by firm holding winner. SECRET CHAT raced two wide in close contention around the first turn, continued to track the pace in close range up the backstretch, came under a ride midway around the far turn, kept on under firm left then right handed pressure and ran on with good response. AIN'T LIFE GRAND was forwardly placed inside around the first turn, stayed inside and stalked up the backstretch, hustled along the rail entering the far turn, angled out near the quarter pole and steadily weakened in the lane. INCA EMPIRE held a slim lead around the first turn, set a pressured pace up the backstretch, could not move on with duo past the mid-way pointaround the far turn and gave way.
