SECRET SAGA ceded the early lead to JADED SECRETS, advanced down the backstretch to be even up with that rival heading into the far turn, edged clear in upper stretch, opened up and held a closing rival safe in the late stages to prevail. RODEO ROSE tracked well off the pace behind the top pair, started to rally heading into the last turn, bid three wide into the stretch and finished well to get second while unable to threaten the winner. JADED SECRETS broke outward at the start then sent aggressively to the front, had a comfortable lead down the backstretch until confronted by SECRET SAGA heading into the last turn, dug in and dueled that rival through the turn then weakened in the final yards. PASSTHE CROWN was outsprinted to the first turn, went three wide then dropped to the rail while running last down the backstretch, was having to be coaxed along to keep pace then was outfinished in the stretch.
