ZZYZX dueled with MACCHIATO D'ORO through the first half-mile, surrendered the lead on the second turn then chased that rival the rest of the way while holding on to the second spot. ANTICIPATED got floated wide in the inital stages then angled overto the rail before the first bend, was content to race there well behind the pace then slipped through an opening just before the last turn and finished well to secure the third prize. RAAJIN RIBBON broke well then floated out the two outside rivals, took back heading into the first turn and settled in a tracking position in the middle of the pack, weakened going into the last turn and had little to offer in the stretch. MR MAKUNOUCHI was off poorly and trailed throughout.
