GAME WARRIOR settled along the inside, made some progress still next to the fence on the far turn, bid between rivals and bumped at the eighth pole, put ahead in front with a sixteenth remaining, drifted out and gamely prevailed. IRON MAN CAL stumbled badly leaving the gate, moved inside, traveled two wide around the far turn, steered back inside in upper stretch, closed well and got up for second. LYLE THE CROCODILE (IRE) hopped at the start, sat off the pace in the two path, swung out leaving the far turn, rallied widest and missed second. ARTISLAS tracked the pacesetter from the rail just out of range early on, tipped off the fence around the far turn and came three wide into the lane, rallied outside the top trio approaching the sixteenth pole, got floated out and kept on gamely to the wire. CALI CAT stalked from inside, followed behind the leader still saving ground on the far turn, tipped out at the top of the lane, challenged with a furlong remaining while getting bumped by GAME WARRIOR, put a head in front midstretch but got outkicked in the last sixteenth. DAY AND AGE tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the two path, spun four wide off the far turn, rallied into contention but got floated out in deep stretch and flattened. INCANTO (IRE) raced up close outside the leader early, remained closest in pursuit in the two path through the far turn but weakened down the lane. KALE'S ANGEL stepped to the front and moved inside, set all the pace to the stretch, confronted by a pair of rivals at the eighth pole and folded in deep stretch. BODI ZAFSA settled three then two wide on the clubhouse turn, asked three wide on the second bend, got carried six wide into the stretch and could not rally. MALA moved inside trailing the field, saved ground through the second bend, moved out approaching the stretch and could not make an impact.
