AUGUST RAIN away alertly and was allowed to settle off the contested early pace while saving ground at the rail through the lane the first time, began to advance three wide midway down the backside to battle for the lead three wide entering the final turn, was unable to match strides with DIOCLES in deep stretch, but finished willingly one out from the rail in deep stretch to prove easily second best. SOARINGFORTHESUN tracked the leader two wide through the first turn, before taking up the chase in the stretch the first time to battle for the lead from the outside of BOLD ARCH, continued their tussle in the run down the backside and into the final turn, was overtaken leaving the turn, but finished two wide in the drive to garner a share. BOLD ARCH broke sharply and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace at the rail in the run to the second turn, continued to set a pressured pace in the run down the backstretch and through the final turn, was overtaken leaving the turn, and faded late. SPACE away well, but was allowed to settle well off the early pace while racing three wide entering the stretch the first time, trailed the field in the run down the backstretch and into the final turn, steadied off heels leaving the turn, and failed to make a late impact.
