**6 FURLONGS. ( 1074 ) VALOR FARM S. Purse \$75,000 FOR ACCREDITED TEXAS-BRED, FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.** No nomination fee. \$375 to pass the entry box and an additional \$375 to start. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry for \$1,125 and shall include all fees. After payment of 1.5% of the purse to all owners finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the winning owner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. If less than five horses start, the remaining purse will be distributed to the winning owner. \*TTA Event Funds are paid directly from the Texas Thoroughbred Association. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. **Weights:** Three Year Olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2025 allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of \$15,000 since January 5, 2025 allowed 4 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Total earnings in 2024-2025, as determined by the information provided by Equibase Company, will be used in determining the order of preference. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

TOO MUCH KIKI, in a bit tight at the break, regrouped and pulled her way forward four wide and between rivals nearing the turn, was patiently handled tracking outside the leader past the five sixteenths, responded when given her cue near mid stretch, seized command a sixteenth out, was given one right handed ask and drew clear. IZATIZ opened up a clear lead soon after the break, set a rated pace towards the inside around the turn, was guided three wide when under some pressure into the lane, dug in when confronted by the winner, gave way grudgingly and was well clear of the rest. OOH LA DA STOOPS stalked the pace three wide, took closer order past the five sixteenths, shifted five wide in upper stretch, chased to mid stretch then came up empty. RECLUSIVE chased the leaders, saved some ground mid turn but failed to drum up a rally. BLING BABY, off a bit slow, saved ground off the pace, advanced under a ride leaving the five sixteenths, drifted out some soon into the stretch, corrected then faded through the final furlong. BLUSHING BELLE, five then four wide pursuing, failed to go on under a ride past the three eighths and gave way.
