( 1014 ) TEXAS THOROUGHBRED ASSOCIATION FUTURITY** Purse \$150,000 ( PLUS UP TO \$15,000 Open ATB ) FOR TTA SALE GRADUATE, FILLIES, TWO YEARS OLD. \$1,125 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,125 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. If less than six horses start, the remaining purse will be distributed to the winning owner. \*TTA Event Funds are paid directly from the Texas Thoroughbred Association. ALL horses that have passed through the ring at the Texas Summer Yearling Sale or the Texas Two-Year-Old In Training Sale are eligible. Weights: 120 lbs. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Order of preference shall be determined as follows: First preference is to horses accumulating the highest total earnings, second preference is to winners at Lone Star Park, third preference is to horses accumulating the highest total earnings at Lone Star Park and fourth preference is to winners. Earnings will be determined by information provided by Equibase Company at the time of entry. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

LANALUAH, away well and held a slim lead between foes nearing the turn, dropped in around the turn and dueled under rating, responded when put to firm asking soon into the stretch, spurred clear under a drive in mid stretch then held firm through the final yards. LITEUPTHENITE broke a step slow, edged up past the half then steadied and altered off heels, dropped inside with a run in upper stretch, came out late and finished gamely to gain. LATE NIGHT TEXT, nudged along early, edged up between foes leaving the far turn and stalked the dueling leaders, shifted out four wide in upper stretch, gave hard chase past mid stretch but came up empty nearing the wire. I LOVE MANGO'S drifted out at the break, corrected and made a quick run to contention outside rivals, emerged in a duel outside the winner leaving the three eighths, battled on near even terms into the lane, failed to match strides while on her left lead leaving the three sixteenths, switched over to her correct lead for the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. KISS MY DICE forced the early pace, raced between runners leaving the far turn, dropped back some past the five sixteenths then came back on with effort in the final furlong. GOLDEN KEEN, forced outward at the break, regrouped, lost ground four to five wide and offered a mild late response. VARINISI drafted back off the early pace, was under a ride mid turn, swung five wide for the drive and churned on. HOT PINK, forward four wide outside foes, chased to upper stretch then faded. WOODALL PASS, taken to rate while saving ground, was stalled mid turn, eased out then steadied off heels soon into the lane. SUPPER CLUB saved ground, briefly waited nearing the quarter pole, found room along the inner rail soon after and weakened. HIDDEN MAP vied inside the winner early on, eased back off that one into the turn, came two wide chasing into the lane and faltered. BELARSEN lost ground five wide mid turn and failed to menace.
