**6 FURLONGS. ( 1.071 ) IOWA SPRINT S. Purse \$100,000 ( plus \$23,880 IBF – Iowa Bred Fund ) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS & UPWARD. Three-Year-Olds – 122 lbs.; Older – 126 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 since October 1st, 2024 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$45,000 October 1st, 2024 allowed 4 lbs.; \$30,000 since October 1st, 2024 allowed 6 lbs. ( Maiden and claiming races not considered) No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and \$1,000 additional to start. ENTRY AND START FEES WILL BE WAIVED FOR ANY HORSE THAT HAS WON A GRADED STAKE IN 2025. \$100,000 guaranteed which will first be reduced so as to allow \$500 to be paid to each of the seventh through last place finishers with the remaining purse paid out as follows: 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS AT TIME OF ENTRY WITH A FEE OF \$2,000 TO ENTER AND START. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds twelve ( 12), high weights will be preferred, then highest 2024–2025 earnings. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Saturday, June 21, 2025 with 30 nominations.**

GLENGARRY quickly cleared the lead and shifted in a few paths after the start, set the pace two wide up the backstretch and kept clear under confident handling around the turn, took on the challenge of RAYMOND at the head of the lane, given cue, responded gamely, repelled bid, widened advantage and kept to task. SECOND I D tracked the pace along the rail in the opening quarter, came under a ride mid-way around the turn, cut the corner entering the upper stretch, sustained inside bid and finished second best. NAVY SEAL raced in the back in the opening quarter, picked up the tempo along the outside late on the turn, swung five wide into the upper stretch and finished with good response. RAYMOND was forwardly placed while the closest pursuer of the early leader, advanced to challenge GLENGARRY for the lead at the head of the lane, could not get by eventual winner, yielded and ran on evenly. DIAMOND RIM was not far back in the opening quarter, chased three to four wide in the lane and needed more for impact. GENERAL SHIPMAN raced off the pace, saved ground and lacked a needed rally. REDLINE showed response in the opening quarter then steadily weakened.
