1 MILE 70 YARDS. (1.39³) IOWA STALLION S. Purse \$70,000 (includes \$2,208 Other Sources) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLD COLTS & GELDINGS WHICH WERE NOMINATED AND REMAIN ELIGIBLE FOR THE 2025 IOWA STALLION STAKES. Weight: 122 lbs.; Non-winners of \$60,000 twice in 2024-2025 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$60,000 once or \$25,000 twice in 2024-2025 allowed 4 lbs.; non-winners of \$25,000 once or \$15,000 twice in 2024-2025 allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered) \$300 to pass the entry box and \$600 to start. \$70,000 added which will first be reduced so as to allow \$500 to be paid to each seventh through last place finishers with the remaining purse paid out as follows: 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. *Late nomination fee of \$15,000 will be accepted at time of entry with \$7,500 allocated towards guaranteed purse monies and \$7,500 to I.T.B.O.A. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to start will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest 2024-2025 earnings at the closing time of entries. This preference will be utilized regardless of the ownership of the horses involved. This race will not be divided and have a maximum number of twelve (12) starters. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees.

TIME TO FLY got bumped at the start but managed to quickly be forwardly placed and matched strides for the lead leaving the first turn, vied briefly setting quick fractions then edged ahead still in hand and led the way going by the half mile marker, widened advantage still unleashed around the far turn, roused for more at the head of the lane, responded willingly and drew off impressively. ABLE SEAMAN was unhurried and raced well off the pace, came under a ride around the far turn, shaken up for the drive, responded and gained second best. FIVE CHARLIE raced off the pace, was ridden along for response around the final turn, ran on into the lane and cleared a share. QUIETLINE was well reserved in the back, given cue in the upper stretch and got up to finish on equal terms for a minor share. ON A HUNCH raced in range up the backstretch, hustled along three to four wide around the final turn, was the closest pursuer of the clear leader in the upper stretch then weakened in the final furlong and finished on equal terms for a minor share. P R MO VISION stalked the pace, urged two to three wide around the final turn then faded in the lane. GOLD JERRY sat near midpack around the first turn, saved ground and settled near mid-range, came under a ride around the final turn, failed to kick on and dropped back in the lane. BOOZEIN THE BLENDER stumbled at the start but managed to be forwardly placed, vied around the first turn, continued to set a quick pace along with eventual winner in the early backstretch, came up empty after the half, dropped back and jogged in.
