1½ MILES. (1.591) SUBURBAN S. PRESENTED BY SUBOURBON Grade II. Purse \$400,000 **FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.** Lasix not allowed within 48 hours of post time pursuant to HISA Rule 4212. By subscription of \$400 which should accompany the nomination. \$2,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,000 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2025 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstakes in 2024 at a mile or over allowed 4 lbs.; of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2024-25 allowed 6 lbs. The first four finishers of the Suburban will have all fees waived if they start in the 2025 Grade One Jockey Club Gold Cup in Saratoga on Sunday, August 31st. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 21, 2025 with 18 Nominations.

PHILEAS FOGG was sent hard to the front, rounded the first turn in the two path, was well rated while showing the way down the backstretch, came under coaxing with a half-mile to run, extended the advantage while inside to the two path on the far turn, responded well when put to a right-handed crop in upper stretch, remained clear under a drive into the final sixteenth and just held while shortening stride late. ANTIQUARIAN bobbled at the start but broke near the front, traveled around the opening bend in the three path, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the two to three path under strong urging on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive, pursued the winner under the crop into the final sixteenth, gained fast on that foe late and just missed while well clear for the place. LOCKED was hustled from the gate, settled on the inside, chased while saving ground on the far turn, dropped back under a drive into upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker and weakened while best of the rest. BENDOOG rounded the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, was roused near the half-mile pole, went around the far turn in the two path under urging, lugged inward in upper stretch and came up empty. SAN SIRO saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along passing the five-eighths pole, went around the far turn in the three path, came into the stretch in the six path and faltered. AWESOME AARON brushed the outside of the gate at the start, raced in the four path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along in the three path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and also faltered. HONOR MARIE lost his footing some in the hindquarters at the start, raced inside to the two path on the turns while urged at the rear and showed little.
