BRING THEBAND HOME established the front and cut the pace just off the inside down the backstretch and then along the inside through the turn, got roused spinning from the two path into upper stretch, drew off under a drive to the finish. WORKS FOR ME got bumped and jostled from the two path near the nine-sixteenths with FELIX who came inwards from the three path, chased two to three wide down the backstretch before committing to the two path through the turn, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and ran on willingly for the place honors. OUTLAW KID chased along the inside coming under a ride near the quarter pole, spun three wide for home, kept on to secure the show honors. MISCHIEVOUS ANGEL shied out at the start filling the space left vacated by OUR SHOT, who broke outwards, chased just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, spun two to three wide for home, improved position to the finish. WITTY five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, stayed on one paced to the finish improving to the wire. OUR SHOT broke out at the start bumping and squeezing out SURVEILLANCE against MATTINGLY, chased three wide under urging from the five-sixteenths, angled out six wide into upper stretch and weakened. AXTHELM a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, chased four paths off the inside until tucked to the two path nearing the seven-sixteenths, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and had no kick. AMERICAN MONARCH three then two wide in closest aim of the leader, got ridden along nearing the quarter pole and swung four wide at the top of the stretch, weakened in the stretch. FELIX tucked inwards from the outside near the nine-sixteenths and bumped and jostled with WORKS FOR ME to his inside, chased three wide patiently handled until set down angled four wide into upper stretch, then weakened in the drive. MATTINGLY broke in at the start bumping SURVEILLANCE in tandem with OUR SHOT and was bumped by the heavier pressure coming from inside and aided in pinching back that middle rival while conceding three lengths to the front himself, chased along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home and made no impact. SURVEILLANCE got bumped between foes who each broke his way and was forced to check when squeezed out between them conceding five to six lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased just off the inside coming under a ride nearing the five-sixteenths, went six to seven wide into upper stretch and was unable to make an impact.
