DETERMINISTIC coaxed from the gate, settled tracking the leader just off the inside through the first turn and then two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch, remained patiently handled until placed to coaxing just off the inside with fivesixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, dug intussling with the former leader before edging away inside the final sixteenth to score. INTELLECT (FR) brushed the off side stall at the start, saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, angled out a path or two a furlong out forcing SPIRIT OF ST LOUIS to check off his heels, then kicked on belatedly to get up for the place honors in the final jumps while never threatening the winner. WIN FOR THE MONEY tracked the pace along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to secure the show honors in the very last stride to the wire. MY BOY PRINCE broke out at the start bumping JOHANNES, showed the way in hand along the inside patiently handled until set down continuing in the inside route into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught a furlong out, fought on to the sixteenth marker, then got out-finished in the late stages. THI NK BIG three then two wide through the first turn, chased three wide coming under a ride three furlongs from home, went seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid but was out-kicked. CUGINO broke out a step at the start, chased along the inside coming under urging with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no response. LAGYN OS three wide through the first turn, raced three then two wide in pursuit from just off the pace, remained patiently handled until called upon spinning three to four wide into upper stretch, stayed on one paced through to the end. SPIRIT OF ST LOUIS settled just off the inside in pursuit from midpack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, got checked a furlong out when INTELLECT tipped out directly infront and made no impact. JOHANNES broke in a step and was bumped solidly by MYBOY PRINCE, who broke outwards, and conceded two to three lengths to the front, grew rank off the heels of a rival and then in tight between foes under restraint into the first turn and to midway through that bend before settling near the rear, remained patiently handled until given a notch to work with midway on the far turn, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and angled six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and made no impact. NEAT four wide through the first turn, chased four wide coming under brief coaxing near the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, got placed to a protective hold and was eased home to the finish, then got pulled up quickly after the wire and was vetted and transported off the course via the equine ambulance.
