REGALED settled to trail through the first turn, stayed off the pace up the backstretch, made a four wide bid exiting the far turn to split foes, surged past rivals in the final furlong to be much the best. RUNAWAY DIVA raced in the middle of the pack, made an inside bid rounding the far turn to enter the stretch for a short lead before giving way in the final fulrong. DAZZLING MOVE showed good early speed, lost ground exiting the far turn to enter the turn five wide, drifted out through the stretch. MAJESTIC OOPS rated in the two path, made no bid, weakened in the stretch. QUEEN OF MISSOULA a step slow out of the gate, raced off the pace on the inside, trailed shortly after the half.
