HACKSAW MOUNTAIN was forced out by MOONRISE SERENADE at the start but corrected and stalked the pace, made a run three wide leaving the quarter pole, rallied to the front into the stretch and held driving. DESIGNATED RUNNER set the pace from the rail for four and a half furlongs, could not stall the winner at the eighth pole but was an easy second. RISE UP AND GO was three wide early, bid two wide to the stretch but did not threaten the top two while well clear of the rest. MOONRISE SERENADE broke out sharply, straightened to press the pace, saved ground but weakened in the drive. PEACE PARDNER was hustled early but still lacked early speed and was always outrun. ALFA SIETE was very green and always well back.
