FULLY SUBSCRIBED four then three wide through the first turn, chased four paths off the inside coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths marker, angled six wide into upper stretch, seized command straightened away, edged clear under a drive to prevail. DREXEL HILL three wide through the first turn, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and remained five wide through the turn when stacked outside rivals, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angle d seven wide into upper stretch, ran on to secure the place honors. LEMON ZEST bobbled at the break and broke on top despite it, chased three then two wide in closest aim of the leader coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, ran on to the finish, SO THERE SHE WAS coaxed from the gate, raced five then four wide through the first turn advancing through the latter half to be forwardly placed five paths off the rail into the backstretch, chased four then three wide coming under urging three furlongs from home, cornered four wide into upper stretch, kept on to the wire. OURDAYDREAMI NGGIRL raced just off the inside through the opening bend, chased three paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking inside through the far turn coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, improved position to the end. QUEENAZTECA bobbled at the break getting away narrowly last, came under coaxing and advanced to take command settling in hand to show the way just off the inside through the first turn, remained just off the rail settling into a comfortably rhythm down the backstretch, tucked inside with half a mile to run, came under pressure from a quartet stacking across the track when placed to encouragement at the threeeighths pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch overwhelmed with challenging rivals and yielded the front, then weakened through to the finish. FILLY FREEDOM three wide through the first turn, chased three then two wide, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide at the top of the stretch and weakened. BEING MYSELF chased along the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled three to four wide at the head of the lane, tired. CUE THE DUCK BOATS coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside under motivation with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch and tired.
