PAIGE TURNER transferred firm contact from an inner for to an outer rival at the start, stalked near the two path, tipped to take aim three wide entering the lane and ran on to be second best. A FINE CHARDONNAY laid off of the pace two to three wide, shifted out to the six path entering upperstretch and rallied willingly to gain show in the final sixteenth. SOLEMN VOW bumped an outer foe at the start, set the pace inside of the eventual winner into and around tehturn, got headed at the three sixteenths pole, proved no match and faded. GO TO GIRL took light contact from an outer foe at the start, laid off of the pace along the inside, shifted out to the five path and between horses in upper stretch but lacked a rally. WOODSTOCK was bumped on both sides at the start, chased in the three path and tired. MACKINAC broke a step slow and bumped an inner foe at the start, laid well back near the inside and made little impact. I B FLYIN broke a bit outwardly, tracked from the four path, chased in the three path around the turn and faded between horses reaching the lane. RIVER RISE broke a step slow and bumped an inner foe at the start, trailed in the two path, swung out to the seven path into upper stretch and never got involved.
