FIFTY CINCO saved ground while unhurried and failed to seriously threaten. COASTAL KID settled in the back of the field early, rallied four-wide the final quarter mile and was not a factor. CREATIVE OM showed brief speed from along the inside and tired. THE JOCKEY OF TIME TO FLY LODGED AN OBJECTON AGAINST DIAMOND RIM BUT AFTER VIEWING THE FILMS THE STEWARDS RULER THERE WAS INSUFFICIENTINTERFERENCE TO MERIT A DISQUALIFICATION AND MADE NO CHANGE IN THE ORDER OF FINISH. RACE WAS HAND-TIMED.
