HONKY TONK HONEY raced in the the middle of the pack on the outside through the opening half mile, navigated the far turn still in the three path and finished evenly. OUR TIME TO SHINE raced in the two path around the first turn, chased the leader up the backstretch, continued around the far turn still in the two path and faded in the lane. COMFORTS JAZEL saved ground around the first turn, settled off the pace on the inside for the run up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the far bend and made no bid.
