BL AZING BRAT tracked three to two wide and between horses, tipped out to the four path in upper stretch and rallied to gain place in the final sixteenth. EVOLUTION vied three to two wide, remained wide and led in the four path around the turn, drew clear while tucking to the three path nearing the lane, hung on her left lead while tiring in the final furlong, got caught at the sixteenth pole, weakened then just saved show at the wire. MY MISS MO bumped an outer rival at the start, pursued along the inside, yielded into the turn, shifted out to the three path in upper stretch, ran on between horses while hanging on her left lead and missed show. FREAKS GO was bumped between horses and pinched back at the start, raced off of the pace in the three to four path into the turn, shifted to the five path into upper stretch and moved up while hanging on her left lead. SUMMER WINNER vied for the lead with an outer pair early on, failed to sustain position and chased around the turn, then tired through the lane. GERRARDS CROSS bumped an inner foe at the start, chased two wide and between horses, got floated to the four path into the lane and tired. TECHSTAR vied two wide and between horses early on, then only inside of her outer counterpart into the turn, gave way to that one at the quarter pole and caved. TREMONT TAMMY broke slowly, trailed in the three path, swung out to the six path into the lane and made little impact.
