MEANING tracked from inside around the first turn, moved out and challenged the top pair at the half-mile pole, ridden along approaching the quarter pole, dueled with EXPLORA into the lane, put a head in front in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and edged clear from the runner-up near the wire. EXPLORA showed speed inside a pair of rivals then got put in tight along the fence on the first turn, found enough room and went up to take over late on the bend, vied with outer duo at the half-mile pole, came under a ride to maintain as slim advantage around the far turn, dueled with MEANING turning for home, lost command in upper stretch, fought back into the last sixteenth and yielded grudgingly in the end. BANK SHOT displayed early quickness from between runners then took a stalking position into the first turn, rounded that bend two then three wide, chased in the four path on the far turn, could not summon the needed rally to threaten the top pair but was able to get by SUPER CORREDORA for the show honors. SUPER CORREDORA took the lead early outside a pair of rivals then cleared BANK SHOT and moved into the two path entering the clubhouse turn, lost command to EXPLORA late on the bend and dueled into the backstretch, vied between rivals at the halfway mark, fought through the far turn in the two path, could not kick on with the leaders at the top of the lane and weakened in the final furlong.
