After payment of 1.5% of the total purse to all owners finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the winning owner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. If less than five horses start, the remaining purse will be distributed to the winning owner. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Weights: Three Year Old, 122 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 at a mile or over in 2026 allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of \$60,000 since November 25, 2025 allowed 4 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances.
